NAILSEA RUNNING CLUB SPECIAL MEETING

With the demise of the A.A.A. Registration Scheme there is a growing opinion among our membership that we should now formalise and as such affiliate to the MIDLAND COUNTIES A.A.A.

In order that we may discuss such a move we are calling a meeting of all members at 7pm, Saturday 14th March 1987, at the Royal Oak, High street, Nailsea.

Attached you will find an agenda for the meeting and also a copy of the proposed club rules/constitution:- these having been based on guidelines given by the A.A.A.

If we decide to affiliate the appropriate committee will need to be elected. It is proposed that the election of office bearers also take place on the 14th (this would obviate the need for another meeting). In preparation for the meeting there are a few things you must do:-

1) Give consideration to whether you wish to be a member of a more formalised club. Such formalising of the club should not have any effect on the fun we have constantly maintained and the social aspect should also continue to flourish.

2) Read the proposed club rules/constitution with a view to suggesting/debating any amendments.

3) Give thought to who you would want as office bearers on any management committee. If you have any individuals(s) in mind then approach them before 14th March to see whether they would be interested/willing to serve in some capacity. Do not turn up on the night and 'surprise' anyone with a nomination they may not have been expecting.

4) Elections (if any are to be held) will be by secret ballot.

5) As nearly half of our membership is female then an appropriate number would be best appointed (if we were to affiliate to A.A.A. the womans section would do so seperately from the mens).

6) Give thought to what you would consider to be an appropriate membership fee.

7) If there is anything else you wish to discuss on 14th March then it can be raised under A.O.C.B.

You have plenty of notice about this meeting so consider it a must that you appear (injured or not).
