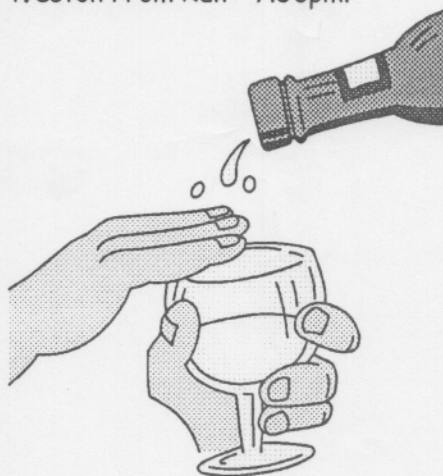
I have competed in approximately 220 races in the Nailsea vest and hope to compete for many more years to come.
